Abortion on Demand

Jim Renacci is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children.

Sherrod Brown supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

Jim Renacci cosponsored and voted for the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act*, legislation to protect unborn children by prohibiting abortion at 20 weeks, a point by which the unborn child is capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Sherrod Brown voted against the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act* (S. 2311).

Sherrod Brown is a co-sponsor of S. 510, a bill that, if enacted, would invalidate nearly all state and federal limitations on abortion.

Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

Jim Renacci voted for the *No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act* (H.R. 7), a bill that would enact a permanent, government-wide prohibition of taxpayer funding for abortion.

Sherrod Brown supports using tax dollars for abortion.

Parental Notice Before Abortion

Jim Renacci supports a bill that would require parental notice before an abortion is performed on a minor daughter.

Sherrod Brown voted against a bill that would require an abortionist to notify at least one parent before performing an abortion on a minor girl from another state.

Government Funding for Abortion Providers

Jim Renacci voted for passage of a bill that would defund Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion provider.

Sherrod Brown voted to provide government funds to the nation's largest abortion provider.

Judicial Nominations to the US Supreme Court

Jim Renacci will support well-qualified persons to the U.S. Supreme Court who will interpret the Constitution according to its text, and who will be willing to reconsider precedents inconsistent with the text of the Constitution.

Sherrod Brown voted against confirmation of Neil Gorsuch to be an associate justice of the U.S. Supreme Court.
